



GUIDELINES FOR USHERS

GREETING:

Arrive at least 20 minutes prior to the service.

2 ushers welcome the worshipers at the front doors while the other 2 ushers greet worshipers with a bulletin inside. You may usher people to their seats.

WORSHIP SERVICE:

After the service begins, one of the ushers must count the worshipers (including all the children and the worship leaders).

Help with the Offering.

COMMUNION/AFTER SERVICE:

Guide worshippers to the front to take communion.

After the service, pick up any papers/trash left in the pews and put hymnals in their proper place. Place all bibles between the hymnals and in front of the Other Song Book.
