# Consecration Sunday is Coming to Grace This Fall!

Jesus summed up the spiritual connection between money and faith with these words from Luke 12:34: Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. By saying this, Jesus is reminding us to avoid the trap of earthly treasures by keeping ourselves spiritually focused on God's true treasure! So I'm wondering...

Would it be possible for us at Grace Lutheran to follow the example of <u>Broadway United Methodist Church</u> in Indianapolis? They took a hiatus from their traditional helping ministries and sent "roving listeners" out into the neighborhood to see what people were doing there and then helped connect them to the church. What would happen if we did that?

Too often in our churches we focus on needs -- the assumption that something is missing. In our families as well as our congregations, we start by searching for solutions to scarcity: how to curb our spending, meet our material needs, or balance our budgets. While these are worthwhile and necessary, I do wonder: What if that approach takes us in the wrong direction?

According to social policy expert <u>John McKnight</u>, "You don't know what you need until you know what you have." As a leading proponent of asset-based community development (ABCD), McKnight suggests flipping the script when trying to work for change in communities: start by discovering the assets, gifts and resources in a community, rather than focusing on what people lack.

One thing that has jumped out at me in my months of serving as the senior pastor at Grace—people here have gifts, talents and enthusiasms. So how can we start with these assets in seeing our faith community in a different way?

One expert in the field puts it this way: While we each must shape our own theology of money, at the core is our response of gratitude to God's generosity. At stake is who God is: God is generous, gracious, loving and merciful.

By now many of you are familiar with my quote from Hudson Taylor: *God's work, done in God's way, will never lack God's supply!* Yes it is important that we take care of our material assets: budgets, buildings, endowments. But if we take another look, can we appreciate the nonmaterial assets? Can we appreciate how our vision and mission are also assets; how they keep us fixed on our goals and keep us from wandering off course.

Beloved in Christ, as we prepare for this fall's Consecration Sunday, I pray you will no longer ask: What does the church need in order to pay its bills? And start asking: What is God calling me to do and give?

In Christ's Resurrected Joy!






## The Red Bucket Ministry For the 2nd Quarter
