# **Painting Beautiful Art**

One of the benefits of Consecration Sunday, besides helping us respond to God's grace by our own spiritual growth and stepping up our giving, is that new people will be attracted to our ministry and mission. Getting excited about giving back to God is catchy!

So, that means this is a great time to invite your neighbor, friend, or relative who might be needing a new church home. And don't worry about getting stuck when

someone responds to your invitation to "come to Grace." They might ask, "What do I do next?" Is there a "step one" that comes to mind? There is! Invite them to attend our Bible study on Thursday mornings at church or Saturday mornings at Uncle Louie's cafe.

Another great response is to tell them to "Go home and read the Sermon on the Mount — chapters 5-7 of Matthew — then try to live your life according to what Jesus said there." If they ask for another step, suggest reading the whole gospel of Luke (or any of the gospels) and do the same thing. "Try to put what you learn about Jesus into practice in your own life." Did you notice in that advice that you are helping them learn the primary meaning of the word "Christian" as a "follower of Jesus" or "imitator of Christ"? In order to really follow Jesus it's good to know about him.

There's a syndicated radio program called *Intelligence for Your Life* hosted by John Tesh that puts out little nuggets of information that give the show its name. They are shorthand "how-to" summaries on all sorts of topics, such as "Four ways to have more joy in your life," "Three ways to make Valentine's Day special this year," "Five ways to get ahead at work" and many more like that. Tesh has a staff that spends hours scouring books, magazines, and websites for the show.

In a sense, telling a new Christian to go home and read the Sermon on the Mount or the book of Luke can be like an "intelligence for your life" piece. But if the person really does it — if we read those Scriptures with the idea that we want to apply what we are learning about Jesus to our own lives, we will be painting beautiful art on the pages of the book that is our life.


