

### Going from Advent and Christmas to Easter

Why end this year with a story about a burial when we are getting ready for Christ's birth? Part of the reason is this is an amazing story. But another reason is that every New Year we move from the cradle to the cross!

The funeral I presided at recently at Black Hills National Cemetery was for a 98-year old cowboy and veteran of

the United States Marine Corps. In his last years he lived in a Rapid City care center. His family says once you heard him laugh, you knew he had a kind heart.

His only granddaughter says her grandpa often gave her perfume and/or jewelry for Christmas—except one Christmas! As she wondered what kind of sparkly thing she would find in her ring box—to her surprise—she found a mouse skull in it. What an intriguing and unusual gift!

In his later years, after serving in the Pacific during World War II, he had a serious case of Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. One time in the care center, a PTSD flashback made him think the Japanese were attacking. Another time, he thought the motel being built across the street was being built by the Russians. He was anxious, afraid, and wanted to leave. But the care center staff and his family came up with clever plan. They told him the Marines sent him a message that he needed to stay put!

In his younger days, after getting back from the war, he was tossed off his horse, broke 6 ribs, and had a punctured lung. Yet, he did not just lay there and wait for help. He got back on his horse, rode up the hill to the barn, unsaddled his horse, went home and changed out of his muddy clothes, and then called for help! Was he a tough cowboy or what?

This man bravely fought and was at the bottom of the hill during the raising of the U-S flag at Iwo Jima. Not bad for a guy who was born in Minnesota and ended up in an orphanage after a family tragedy—and then was raised by a foster family on a farm by Carter down by Mission.

His wife's most cherished artwork is of Jesus cradling a lamb in his arms. And she was glad I always recite the Lord's Prayer at every funeral. As the senior pastor of the largest Lutheran church in Sturgis, I have called to preside over many nonmember funerals out there, but this was by far the biggest!

Now as we move from the manger to the cross in the New Year, I pray we will trust Christ's forgiveness and grace, making 2024 the best ever!




