First Fruits Giving-Based on Love

I want to start this article with a question: When we give our tithes and offerings—do we do "first fruit giving"? That means the first gift we give is a tithe to God, not ourselves, after we deposit our monthly income.

The tradition for doing that goes back to the book of Genesis. In Genesis 14:20 after God blessed Abraham, the patriarch's response was: "And Abram gave him one tenth of everything." In Abraham's case, that meant making sacrifices of animals, gathering grain, and offering them to God.

Such offerings no longer need to happen—because of Jesus, we no longer have to bring animal sacrifices or grain offerings to God like they did in Abraham's day. Christ's sacrifice covers it all. When we place our trust in him, we go directly to him for forgiveness. We give him our thanks and also tell him our needs.

Another interesting Old Testament ritual is described in Leviticus 8:22-24: Then he brought forward the second ram...Moses took some of its blood and put it on the lobe of Aaron's right ear and on the thumb of his right hand and on the big toe of his right foot. After Aaron's sons were brought forward, Moses put some of the blood on the lobes of their right ears and on the thumbs of their right hands and on the big toes of their right feet; and Moses dashed the rest of the blood against all sides of the altar."

Scholars have identified what this is about. The blood put on the lobes of their right ears was to help them listen to God; on their thumbs for doing God's work; and on their big toes to go out and share God's love.

So without doing those types of rituals, how can we do the same? One key way is in "first fruit giving"! When we dedicate our tithes and offerings and make sure to give to God first before anything else, we are showing we've heard God and we are willing to respond to God's love by doing and sharing that love.

I have been a first fruits giver and tither for all 30 years of my pastoral ministry. At times, I am tempted to think I need to keep more. But then I realize I have been blessed beyond measure—materially, spiritually, and with family, friends, and this congregation. Truly, first fruit giving means responding joyfully to God's care, which is always based on love.

GUIDELINES FOR COFFEE HOUR HOSTS

- 1. There should be cookies, bars, or other snacks available for Sunday coffee hour. If two families are serving, each should bring 6 doz.
- 2. Coffee and juice will be mixed in the kitchen. Check the refrigerator for leftover juice to be used.
- Coffee must be made and turned on before the 9:00 am service. Make both big pots of coffee and one small pot of decaf each Sunday. More may be required depending on the Sunday demand.
- 4. Set out offering basket, napkins, and cups.
- 5. After everyone has passed through the line, you may offer refills of coffee, juice, and treats.
- 6. Clear and wipe off tables when people leave.
- 7. Take coffee offering to the office if a teller does not pick it up.
- 8. Coffee hosts will serve from 10:00 am to 11:00 am. If anyone stays after 11:00 am it will be their responsibility to clean up.
- 9. Please clean dishes, coffee pots, counter tops, etc. in the kitchen before leaving. Take the dirty towels home, launder them, and return them the following Sunday.

We thank you for your time and service to our church in this way. Coffee fellowship is an important ministry of this congregation.

Notes to Serving Grace people:

- Please try to have at least one experienced person serve each week, especially when there are new people. These experienced people will help show the new ones how to make coffee, find serving trays, etc. or ask someone at coffee for help. Everyone is glad to help.
- Instructions for making coffee are on the cupboard above the coffee pots.

• Please keep your receipts and turn them into the office if you would like to be reimbursed.

Worship Committee Minutes, Sept. 16, 2025




Old Business:
