The Resurrection Promise

Enemies and friends of Jesus waited. On the third day after his crucifixion, even though the chief priests and Pharisees had posted guards—they were no longer guarding a dead body! The stone that had sealed the entrance of the tomb was rolled away. Sitting on it was an angel, whose appearance had jolted the guards into a state of shock as they "became like dead men." And then the angel spoke to the women. Do not be afraid, I know that you are looking for Jesus who was crucified. He is not here; for he has been raised, as he said (Matt. 28:5–6).

Truly, the Resurrection was an unexpected event. Even though the Lord had foretold this, his disciples were unprepared. When the reports came in about our Lord's resurrection, they struggled to believe it. But in the 40 days that our risen Lord appeared to his disciples and many others, the evidence of the world's biggest miracle was starting to accumulate.

Eventually St. Paul wrote this: For what I handed onto you as of first importance what I in turn had received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures, and that he was buried, and that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers and sisters at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have died. Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles. Last of all, as to one untimely born, he appeared also to me.

1 Corinthians 15:3–8

So, what does the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ mean for us? When Paul wrote the above words, he said he was "one untimely born." He wanted to meet the resurrected Jesus face-to-face upon this earth. Paul has certainly now met him in the heavenly realm. But what about us? Are we untimely born? I do not think very many of us would want to trade in our 21st century comforts for the harsh reality of living in the first century! But maybe we can find a way to share the love and forgiveness of Christ in a special way in the here-and-now!

I have been taking our Church Council through the LEAD (Living Everyday As Disciples) Playbook that we received at last year's synod assembly. It is an excellent resource. The authors write: "Every Christian community is wondering how to be church right now. People are starving for deeper conversations about faith and life - but not turning to the church for answers. How do we move from the past, through this in-between time, into the future together?"

Eventually, our Council is going to form a cohort to join with lay leaders from other area ELCA churches in a three-year process. The journey will lead us into a renewed faith and into more meaningful connections in our neighborhoods. If you are interested in going on this journey, I want to hear from you. The adventure awaits! The resurrection calls for us to pray, listen deeply, and work together to build something new. Jesus is counting on us to bring his Good News out!




